

CAMPGROUND RULES / IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ

1. You will be taking Metro North to the Beacon train station, or parking at the station. When you arrive go down the steps and exit out the left side which is the **mountain side** of the train station go up the steps or ramp but continue left to the bus area where the **Green shuttle bus** will be waiting. **Please don't go to the river side you will miss your shuttle.**

2. Please buy your water before getting on the train the only store is at hike 3 and the shuttle doesn't stop at stores. There is no bathrooms at the train station, so please don't waste your fellow campers time or the shuttles time looking for one.

3. While on the train, make sure you get ready for your hike, or better yet be ready before you get on the train. Such as your shoes, backpack, water, bug spray, whatever you are going to take on your hike with you. We will take the remainder of your gear to your site.

4. If driving please allow enough time for traffic you never know what you can come across on the roads. Parking will be at the Beacon train station. When arriving at the station go to the first stop sign turn right into the middle parking lot and park there if possible. If parking during the week you must pay. Please bring all your gear to the bus area, please remember the shuttle run with the train schedule which is on the hour.

5. There is no glass permitted (wine, beer, liquor) all must be in plastic, cardboard or can containers. Just remember no glass items.

6. There are no open bags such as shopping, beach, or purses. All gear is transported to your site by atv's. You must have your gear secured. Remember there

is 1 sleeping bag, 1 backpack or duffle bag, 1 mat per person and 1 cooler per site. Please no items sticking out of your bags such as marshmallow forks and hiking sticks. Sleeping bags and sleep items must all be in a bag or it will not be transported.

7. The camp cell phone is 845-629-3051. If you miss your train please call this # right away so we can set you up for a later shuttle.

8. Maps can be purchased on the bus or you can buy them through NYNJ trail conference. East Hudson Trails Map 102. Maps are recommended for hike 2&3.

9. The last shuttle of the day will be the 5:00 train except for the beginning and the end of the season where we would have to work with the sunset. You need to be here an hour before it sets. You are not allowed on the trails in the dark. So please keep this in mind when making your reservation.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If cancellation is made at least 5 days prior to arrival date, payment will be refunded less \$20.00 cancellation fee per site. If notification is made less than five days away from the reservation or if you make your reservation during the 5 days prior to your arrival there will be no refund. There will be no refund or credit for inclement weather or early departure.

Campsites are to be left the way that they are found. If not, a \$40 charge will be added to your credit card.
